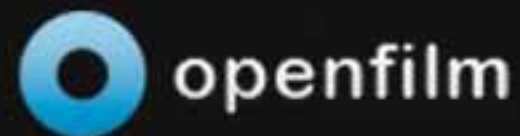

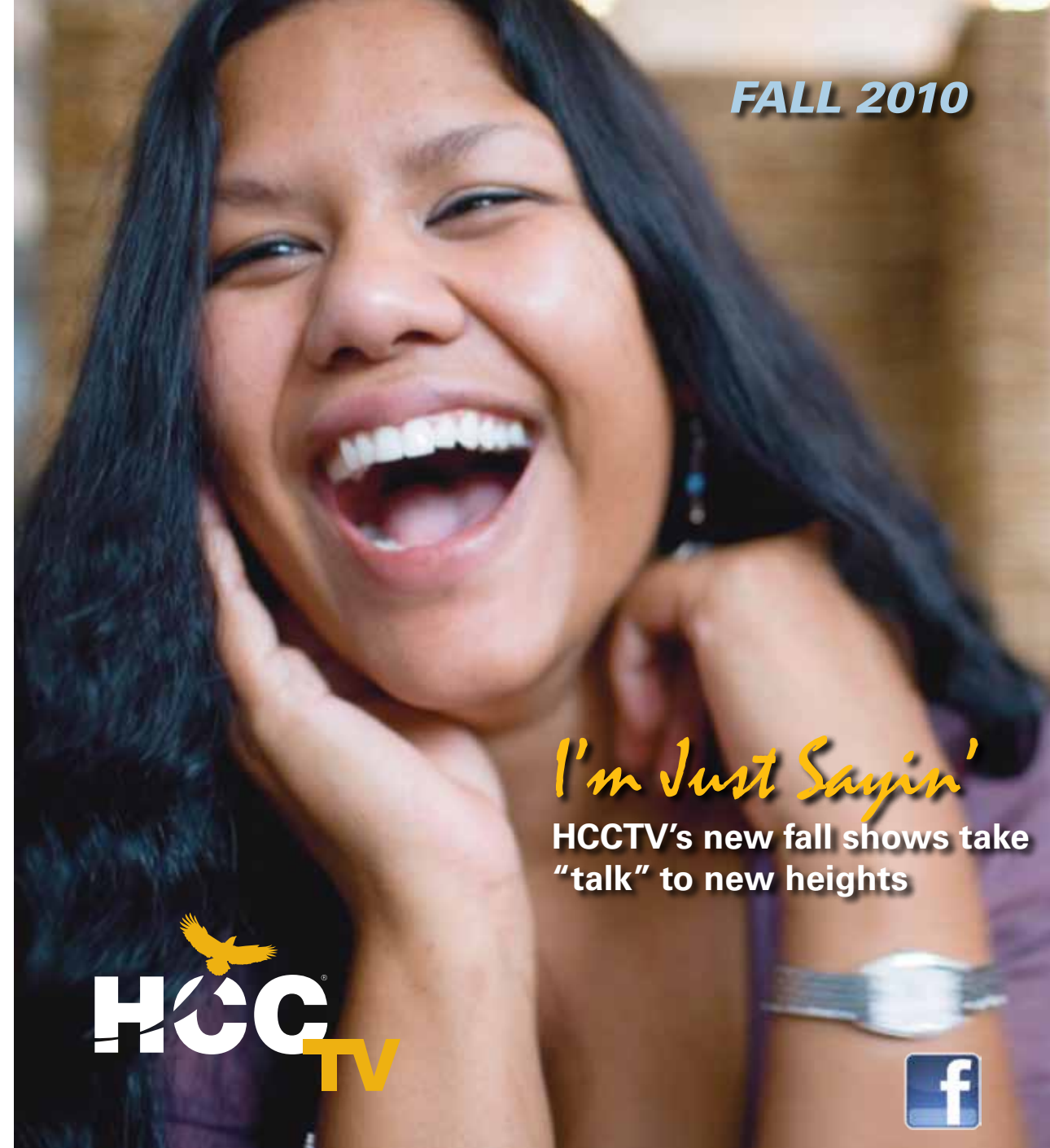


### HCCTV partners with independent filmmaking website!

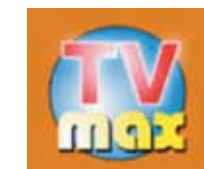
